Subject: Request for Concessionary Tariff Rate on Supply of Electricity and Gas

The undersigned is directed to enclose Federal Board of Revenue (FBR)'s O.M No.4(10) ST-L&P/ZR/Adj/21 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2021 on the subject cited above and state that M/s Dawood Textile Printing (Pvt) Ltd (NTN 658545-7) and M/s Silver Line Spinning Mills (Pvt) Ltd (NTN 2140779-7) were temporarily shifted out of ATL status of FBR due to late filing of sales tax returns but later on became active before the generation of electricity/gas bills and are therefore entitled to reduce tariff rates for that period but the utility provider companies refused to allow reduced tariff rates for the said period.

Subject: Request for Concessionary Tariff Rate on Supply of Electricity and Gas

I am directed to refer to FBR's O.M. of even number dated 01.04.2021 on the subject whereby it was conveyed that instructions may be issued to all utility providing companies to ensure that reduced tariff benefits is allowed to the taxpayers who appear on ATL at the time of finalization of billing circle and that the aspect of non ATL status in the past should not be considered.

2. M/s Dawood Textile Printing (Pvt) Ltd (NTN 658545-7) and M/s Silver Line Spinning Mills (Pvt) Ltd (NTN 2140779-7) have approached FBR (copies enclosed) stating that both the taxpayers were temporarily shifted out of ATL status of FBR due to late-filing of sales tax returns but later-on became active before the generation of electricity/gas bills and are therefore entitled to reduced rate tariff for that period but the utility provider companies refused to allow reduced rate tariff for the said period.

3. The requests of taxpayers are forwarded for taking further action in the light of FBR's above referred letter dated 01.04.2021.
